# **BARN ENGINES & EQUIPMENT METHOD STATEMENT**

### 1 Barn Engine Displays

- a) Owners of stationary (barn) engines who are not members of the Combe Mill Society must have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- b) Fuel for engines shall be stored in appropriate closed containers and these to be located at a distance from any sources of spark, heat or open flame. A minimum of fuel is to be stored on site.
- c) The area within which stationary engines are operated shall be fenced off from the public.
- d) The public shall not be permitted to enter the barn engine store.

### 2 Associated Equipment

- a) Machinery that is driven from a barn engine must be fitted with guards over all moving parts.
- b) The area within which machinery is operated shall be fenced off from the public.
- c) Non-working equipment shall have no unprotected sharp edges or openings where small fingers might become trapped.

### 3 PPE

The following PPE should be worn by persons operating Barn engines and associated equipment:

- 1) Overalls or boiler suit
- 2) Appropriate gloves.
