Method Statement - External Displays & Picnic Area

1 Picnic Area

- a) The picnic area must be presented to the public in a safe condition i.e. with the grass mown and any molehills flattened.
- b) All external equipment, picnic tables, seats etc. must be checked for safety before each public steaming.
- c) No persons may swim in the river.
- d) "Deep Water" warning notices are to be permanently displayed adjacent to the river.
- e) The route of any cables or hoses that are laid across the picnic area when the public are present must be clearly marked and all steps taken to prevent trip hazard.
- f) All rubbish shall be removed from the picnic area at the end of steaming events.
- h) Picnic benches to be moved to higher ground when the river level is predicted to rise to flood level.

2 External Displays

Non-working displays may from time to time be sited in the picnic area and must be located clear of any working machinery.

3 PPE

There are no specific PPE requirements for this area.
