WHAT IS THE MONEY TO BE USED FOR?

The present waterwheel at Combe Mill was installed around 1860 and it runs on a timber shaft. On the end of this axle tree is a pit-gear which transfers the water power to drive machinery. This pit-gear has wooden teeth which were

of urgent replacement if we are to run the wheel in 2016.

There are 162 gear teeth to be made of dried oak and the cost of the materials and labour is significant.

We are seeking sponsors to provide a minimum of £20 per tooth towards the cost.

Each tooth will be numbered and a scroll of honour will be displayed in the gear-room to

record the names of sponsors. Each sponsor will also receive a personalised certificate.

We are working with carpenters at the Wood Centre run by the Sylva Foundation at Little Wittenham to benefit from their skills and experience.
